BACKGROUND

The work contemplated for this project includes removing and reinstalling passenger loading float, dredging and disposal of sediments, and performing final post-dredge surveys.

Maintenance dredging of the Vallejo – Baylink Ferry Terminal is required on an ongoing basis to support continued ferry operations. The ferry terminal once again is in need of dredging to maintain the service. The last dredging episode occurred in 2003 between the months of August and October.

In December 18, 2007, the City Council authorized the City Manager to execute a consultant services agreement with CLE Engineering (CLE) of Richmond, California for professional engineering services to acquire all permits and prepare all construction documents for maintenance dredging work at the Vallejo – Baylink Ferry Terminal.

CLE has completed their assigned tasks, including preparation of plans and specifications for bidding the work. Hydrographic measurements of the dredge area have been obtained and documented. Dredge volumes have been calculated. Sediment samples have been obtained and tested showing no adverse findings. A plan for temporary relocation of passenger ferry operations has been completed. All of these components are included in the City's master dredging permit application.

The master dredging permit application was prepared and forwarded to the Dredge Materials Management Office (DMMO) for approval. The DMMO board consists of the following eight agencies: (1) Bay Conservation & Development Commission (BCDC), (2) U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, (3) San Francisco Bay Regional Water Quality Control Board, (4) U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), (5) California State



Lands Commission, (6) California Department of Fish & Game, (7) U.S. National Marine Fisheries Service and (8) U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service. Initial feedback from the DMMO is that the City's application looks to be in good order. Final DMMO approval was received on July 8, 2008. The City has completed the approval process from the eight agency board to perform the work.

In order to completely dredge the basin, the existing gangway and float must be disconnect and removed. The existing gangway and float will remain in service in order to provide ferry service until a time that a temporary float and gangway are installed just south of the basin in the area behind the Vista Dental Building (see the site map). The old passenger float will be utilized for temporary ferry operations. It is anticipated that ferry service will not be disrupted. However, passenger loading and unloading times may become slightly longer due to somewhat narrower ramps and gangways.

While the existing float and gangway are removed and out of service, the City under a separate contract will perform preventative maintenance and painting of passenger float. Once dredging is complete, the new float and gangway will be reinstalled by the dredging contractor. Once re-installed, ferry operation will revert to normal and the temporary float and gangway will be removed and returned to the ferry maintenance facility at Mare Island. Temporary ferry operations are expected to last for six weeks starting on or around September 9, 2008.

The 4 bids received on August 14, 2008 for the Maintenance Dredging Vallejo – Baylink Ferry Terminal Project are as follows:

Salt River Construction Corp. Tiburon CA	\$282,400.00
Dutra Dredging, San Rafael CA	\$ 400,500.00
Manson Construction Co., Seattle WA	\$ 478,700.00
Gordon N. Ball Construction Alamo CA	\$727,000.00

Gordon N. Ball's Construction bid was deemed non-responsive; as their bid package was submitted incomplete.

The apparent low bidder, Salt River Construction Corp was responsive in submitting all required documents and upon investigating references submitted by the low bidder, Salt River Construction is deemed responsible and acceptable for performing this work.

Fiscal Impact

The City obtained federal capital grant of \$800,000 for this project. In addition \$200,000 has been provided from State Proposition 1B. Approximately \$150,000 is already obligated for permitting and preparation of plans and specifications. Therefore,



\$850,000 remains to fund the dredging work and the repairs and painting of the passenger float. The call for bids is solely for the dredging work. There will be no impact on the City's General Fund.

RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends adopting the resolution 1) approving the plans and specifications and 2) awarding a construction contract to Salt River Construction Corp, Tiburon, California in the amount of \$282,400.00 for the Maintenance Dredging, Vallejo-Baylink Ferry Terminal Project.

ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEW

Dredging of the Vallejo - Baylink Ferry Terminal qualifies as a CEQA Class 4 categorical exemption (15304 (g)) – Maintenance dredging where the spoils are deposited in a spoil area authorized by all applicable state and federal regulatory agencies) under Sections 21083 and 21087of the Public Resources Code. No dredging will take place until all permits have been issued by applicable state and federal regulatory agencies. A Notice of Exemption has been filed with the Solano County Clerk on May 22, 2008.

ALTERNATIVES CONSIDERED

A "No Dredging" option was considered but not recommended. The build-up of sediment around the facilities will hamper the operations of the ferry vessels.
