# F. AUTHORIZE THE CITY MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE AND EXECUTE AGREEMENTS FOR THE CAPITOL STREET STAIRS PROJECT NOT TO EXCEED \$149,000 IN COMBINED VALUE

- 2. Waive 50% of project permit fees up to a maximum of \$25,000, whichever is less, to be absorbed by the General Fund for the public benefit of complete permitted plans from a certified engineer.
- Reaffirm the allocation of \$24,000 in PB funds for the artistic tiles and extend the PB grant agreement timelines to align with the Project Schedule.
- 4. Require that all remaining funds required to fully complete the project will be raised by the community, and no public funds may be expended until such fundraising is complete.
- 5. Funds will be paid on a reimbursement basis only for built infrastructure, durables, and/or services resulting in a public benefit.
