9. <u>Public Hearings</u>

a. Housing and Community Development Needs - Continued

The City of Vallejo is required by the U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) to prepare a Consolidated Plan. The Consolidated Plan concerns housing and community development needs. The City's next Consolidated Plan will include the period beginning July 1, 2010, and ending June 30, 2015. The City's deadline for submitting the Consolidated Plan to HUD is May 14, 2010.

Before a draft of the Consolidated Plan is prepared, the City is required to hold at least one public meeting to gather information and receive comments

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on housing and community development needs in Vallejo. On December 10, 2009, the Commission opened a public hearing on housing and community needs, and received comments from the public. Afterwards, the Commission voted, 3-2-0, to continue the public hearing to its next regular meeting. This hearing will also provide another opportunity for residents and other interested parties to comment on how the City's Federal Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program and HOME Investment Partnerships Program funds may be used in Fiscal Year (FY) 2010/2011.

For more information, (1) a copy of the January 7, 2010, public hearing notice, and (2) the staff report dated December 10, 2009, is enclosed.
