  - a. <u>Revision of Chapters Eight, Nine, Ten, Eleven, Thirteen, and Sixteen of the</u> <u>Administrative Plan of the Housing Authority of the City of Vallejo</u>

In April 2008 Legal Services of Northern California and the National Housing Law Project submitted comments regarding the Annual Plan of the Housing Authority of the City of Vallejo. The majority of the comments pertained to the content of the Administrative Plan. Revisions to Chapters Eight, Nine, Ten, Eleven, Thirteen, and Sixteen of the Administrative Plan have been predicated by those comments, as well as an ongoing effort to update the Administrative Plan to bring it into compliance with the changing policies of the U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). For more information, a staff report is enclosed with the agenda.

<u>Recommendation</u>: Review Chapters Eight, Nine, Ten, Eleven, Thirteen, and Sixteen of the Administrative Plan and adopt the resolution enclosed with the agenda recommending approval of the revised chapters by the Housing Authority Board.

b. Section 8 Management Assessment Program Certification for Fiscal Year 2007/2008

of Housing and Urban Development. SEMAP is used by HUD to determine the effectiveness and efficiency of Housing Authorities. Final scoring of the certification indicates that the Vallejo Housing Authority is a standard performer. For more information, a staff report is enclosed with the agenda.

c. <u>City Council Ad Hoc Committee Request for List of Commission Accomplishments and</u> <u>Specific Goals</u>

The City Clerk has indicated that a City Council-appointed Ad Hoc Committee is preparing a report to the City Council which will review the functions of the City's Boards and Commissions, and is requesting a list of accomplishments and specific goals. d. <u>Execution of Housing Assistance Payments Contract for Project Based Vouchers at Avian</u> <u>Glen Apartments</u>

On May 9, 2006, the Housing Authority Board adopted a resolution approving Chapter 25 of the Administrative Plan, which approved the implementation of a Project Based Voucher (PBV) Program. On August 15, 2006 the Vallejo Housing Authority (VHA) issued a Request for Proposals to project base units in existing housing. Avian Glen Apartments was one of two communities selected for the Project Based Voucher Program. The U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development has approved this project, and the Housing Assistance Payments (HAP) Contract for Project Based Vouchers at Avian Glen is ready for execution.

- Recommendation: Recommend that the Housing Authority Board authorize the Executive Director, or his designee, the Assistant City Manager/Community Development, or the Housing and Community Development Manager, to execute a PBV HAP Contract with Avian Glen Apartments dated for reference December 1, 2008.
