12. Public Hearings

a. Proposed Fiscal Year (FY) 2014/2015 Action Plan, and Proposed FY 2014/2015 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program and HOME Investment Partnerships Program Funding Allocations

In April 2013, the City Council approved the allocation of CDBG Program and HOME Program funds for FY 2013/2014, and estimated CDBG Program and HOME Program funds for FY 2014/2015. The City has received notification from HUD that it will receive \$943,998 in CDBG Program funds, and \$409,765 in HOME Program funds, during FY 2014/2015. Staff estimates that the City will receive \$24,000 in CDBG program income, and \$200,000 in HOME program income, in FY 2014/2015. Therefore, the total amount of funding anticipated to be available is \$967,998 (CDBG), and \$609,765 (HOME).

On April 9, 2014, a Commission Ad Hoc Committee on Funding Allocations

(Brown, Ad Hoc Committee Chair; Parker; Tipton) met with staff to develop FY 2014/2015 funding recommendations. The Committee and staff recommend that the activities approved in April 2013 for FY 2014/2015 be ratified again.

A staff report will be provided under separate cover.

Recommendation: After holding a public hearing, adopt two motions: (1) recommending approval by the City Council of an FY 2014/2015 CDBG Program allocation engineering and design of a St. Vincent's Hill Streetscape Master Plan ("Mean Streets to Green Streets"), as presented by a Commission Ad Hoc Committee, and staff; and (2) recommending approval by the City Council of the FY 2014/2015 Action Plan, including FY 2014/2015 CDBG Program and HOME Program funding recommendations, and not including an FY 2014/2015 CDBG Program allocation for the engineering and design of a St. Vincent's Hill Streetscape Master Plan ("Mean Streets to Green Streets"), as presented by a Commission Ad Hoc Committee, and staff.
