12. Public Hearings

a. Draft Fiscal Year (FY) 2015-16 Consolidated Annual Performance and Evaluation Report ("CAPER")

Staff has prepared a draft CAPER for the first year of the City's Consolidated Plan. The Consolidated Plan is a five year planning document required by HUD, and is intended to address community development and affordable housing needs in Vallejo. The Plan includes the period beginning July 1, 2015 and ending June 30, 2020. The draft CAPER describes the City's progress in achieving the objectives in the Consolidated Plan for the period beginning July 1, 2015 and ending June 30, 2016.

Recommendation: Conduct a public hearing. By motion, recommend approval of the FY 2015-16 CAPER by the City Council.

13. Administrative Items

a. Election of Officers

Section 1.01 of the Commission's By-Laws state that the Commission shall elect a Chair and a Vice Chair at the first regular meeting of the new fiscal year, (starting July 1). Per the By-Laws, no commissioner may serve more than two consecutive one-year terms as Chair or Vice Chair.

Commissioner Tipton served as Chair in FY 2015-16, and is eligible to serve another term as Chair. Commissioner Stout served as Vice Chair in FY 2015-16, and has not applied for appointment to another term on the Commission. The Brown Act expressly prohibits secret ballots,
