A. ELECTION OF OFFICERS

B. HOUSING AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF VALLEJO ANNUAL PLAN, FISCAL YEAR 2009-2010

The U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) requires Housing Authorities to prepare an Annual Plan for the Section 8 Housing Choice Voucher (HCV) Program, one of the programs administered by the City's Housing and Community Development Division. It is now time to prepare and submit the Annual Plan for FY 2009-2010. The draft Plan, with a fiscal year from July 1, to June 30, provides details regarding the Authority's immediate operations. On April 7, 2009, the Housing Authority is scheduled to hold a public hearing to receive comments on the Plan. This Plan must be submitted to HUD by April 17, 2009.

C. STUDY SESSION ON OVERVIEW OF HOUSING IN VALLEJO

In October 2008, the Vallejo City Council finalized and codified their collective goals in an Areas of Focus document. Under the heading "Improve Quality of Life", the Council stated that one of their goals was to ensure a range of housing options available to the community with a focus on homeownership. This report will provide an overview of available housing in Vallejo, address housing needs, and provide staff recommendations for the use of allocated affordable housing funds.
