6. CLARIFICATION ON NUMBER OF PROPOSALS FOR CITY REVIEW AND ON THE BALLOT

At the March 18th Regular Meeting, the Steering Committee approved procedures for determining how many proposals each committee can submit for City review and the ballot. PBSC Chair Daniels and Vice Chair De La Torre along with PB staff are seeking clarification on how to operationalize these procedures. They will present some recommendations, and the Steering Committee will consider whether a new or amended motion is necessary.

7. ROLE OF STEERING COMMITTEE IN BUDGET DELEGATE PHASE

The Steering Committee will review their role in the budget delegate phase according to the Rulebook and discuss how to provide support to delegates.

8. UPDATES ON BUDGET DELEGATE PHASE
